

## THE MOST HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY (YEAR B) SUNDAY 30th MAY 2021

*"The eleven disciples set out for Galilee to the mountain where Jesus had arranged to meet them. When they saw him they fell down before him, though some hesitated. (Matthew 28: 16-17) "*

Today's gospel reading is the closing verses of the gospel of Matthew and they illustrate very well the growing faith of the early church in what Jesus has revealed. The life, death and resurrection of Jesus witness to the activity of God the Father through him, and now at the end of the gospel we see Jesus not leaving his disciples but promising to be with them until the end of time as they fulfil their mission of making disciples of all nations by baptising them and teaching them to observe his commands. This text is ideal for today as it is a reminder that faith in the Trinity brings with it a mission to let the whole world hear the good news about God.

**GIFT AID SCHEME ENVELOPES:** New Gift Aid envelopes come into use on the first Sunday in June and the Gift Aid organisers will be in the porch of the Presbytery to hand out the envelopes before and after all Masses on this weekend of 29/30 May and on 5/6 June. If you have signed a Gift Aid Declaration please make sure to collect your supply of new envelopes on one of those weekends.

New members will also be most welcome to join. All that is required is that you use an envelope which is provided for the money you put in the collection and that you sign a form to confirm you are a taxpayer and wish the tax you have paid on the money you put in the collection to be paid to the parish. You do not have to commit to any particular amount of contribution but if you join the scheme every pound you put in your envelopes will be worth £1.25 to the Church.
