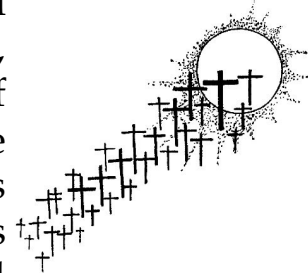
### **THANKSGIVING SUNDAY**
